Types of Clouds

Supplies: blue construction paper, cotton balls, glue, cloud labels

Directions:

- I. Fold the construction paper into fourths.
- 2. Label each box with a different type of cloud
- 3. Use cotton balls to make each cloud type and then glue it down in the right box

Cloud Labels

Cumulus clouds are fluffy and white with flat bottoms.

Cumulonimbus clouds larger and darker on the bottom and may produce thunderstorms.

Stratus clouds are smooth, gray clouds that cover the whole sky (and block out direct sunlight). Light rain and drizzle are usually associated with stratus clouds.

Cirrus clouds are feathery clouds. They are associated with fair weather. Cirrus clouds often indicate that rain or snow will fall within several hours.
